Read Isaiah 52v13-53v12

What do we learn about God’s servant, what he will do and how he will do it?

Take some time to reflect on and respond to this passage in prayer.

Bringing these two passages together; how do they expand our view of Jesus and His mission in the world?

We have been chosen and God delights in us because of what Jesus has done on the cross. In John 20.21 Jesus says “As the Father sent me I send you”. We are now servants of the Lord, His spirit is on us, what does it mean for us to be servants and bringers of God’s kingdom as prophesied here in Isaiah?

How can we bring those things – in our families, at Queens and in society as a whole?
