- 597 BC: Babylonian siege
- 587 BC: Jerusalem ransacked
- 539 BC: Persian take over
- 538 BC: first exiles return
- 515 BC: temple rebuilt, but...
- 444 BC (approx) Neh 1:1

1. Vision begins with a clash between what is and what should be (v.3)

2. God-given vision gets personal in prayer (v.4-11)



**e:con** 3. Vision usually requires waiting

- The opportunity of waiting:
- Prayer: for opportunity
- for favour
- Planning: get ready to move



**e:con** Personal Reflection

- Do you have a sense of the next step (are you praying and planning)?
