

# TEAM DYNAMICS

1. **A good team is a God-confident team**
  - ⇒ A team of faith, looking up, not inward
  
2. **Rather than being threatened by differences, a good team celebrates diversity of personalities and background and uses it to their advantage**
  - ⇒ What are the strengths of the diversity of people on Committee?
  - ⇒ What does each member bring that is positive?
  
3. **A good team has a common vision and a common goal bigger than themselves**
  - ⇒ Diverse backgrounds and personalities but with one goal or vision
  
4. **A good team works together and makes caring for and loving each other a priority**
  - ⇒ Just as important as what you do for God this year is how you love each other as a team
  - ⇒ Loving each other well involves building trust
  - ⇒ How do you build trust within your team?
  
5. **A good team treats conflict as normal and healthy and deals with it in an open, loving and humble manner.**
  - ⇒ Humility is vital
  - ⇒ Don't make assumptions! Ask questions
  - ⇒ Approach the person with an attitude of a learner
  - ⇒ Invite dialogue
  - ⇒ Take the lower place
  - ⇒ Affirm the friendship at the beginning and at the end
  - ⇒ Work hard at listening to make sure you understand

Not to **express** my anger or frustration with you to get it off my chest

Not to **suppress** it and pretend that it doesn't bother me or will go away

But to **confess** and seek reconciliation (that I have been angry and frustrated but my goal is reconciliation, to learn from you, to be close to you.
