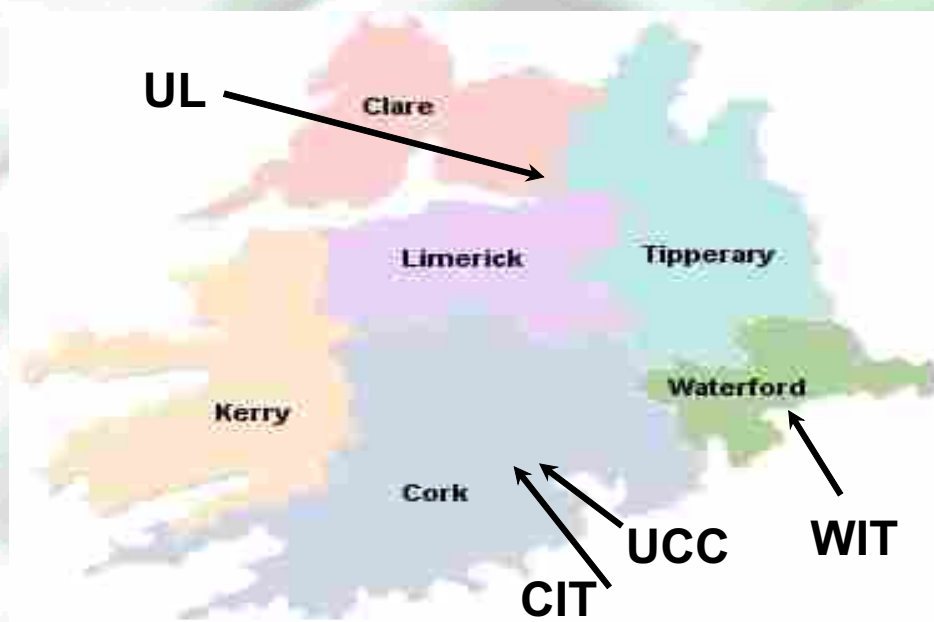


# Prayer Guide

## Munster Christian Unions



### WIT CU (3-4 students)

Peter and Elma are helping the CU work through Mark's gospel this semester.

Pray that more students who are already Christians will come along and get involved in the CU.

### UL CU (20-30 students)

### UCC CU (10-15 students)

Pray for perspective and wisdom for the new committee as they juggle study, friendships with classmates and CU.

Pray that the Holy Spirit will bring unity in the CU and for perseverance for the CU leaders (especially Donal the president) as they seek to model evangelistic lifestyles.
