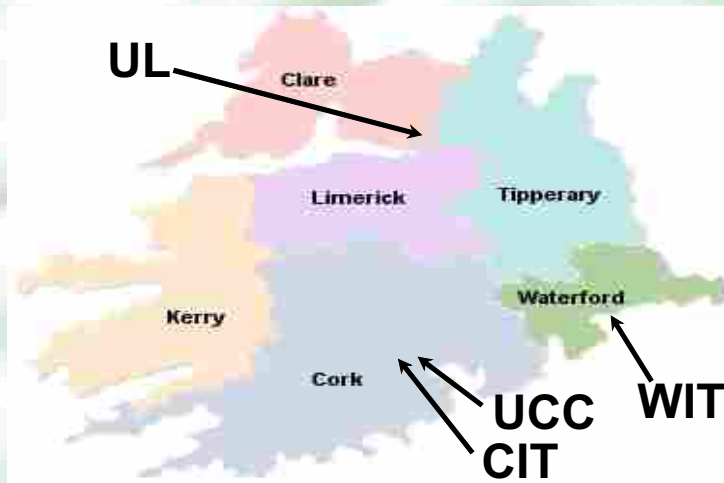


Prayer Guide

Pray for the committee as they decide on a new leadership team.

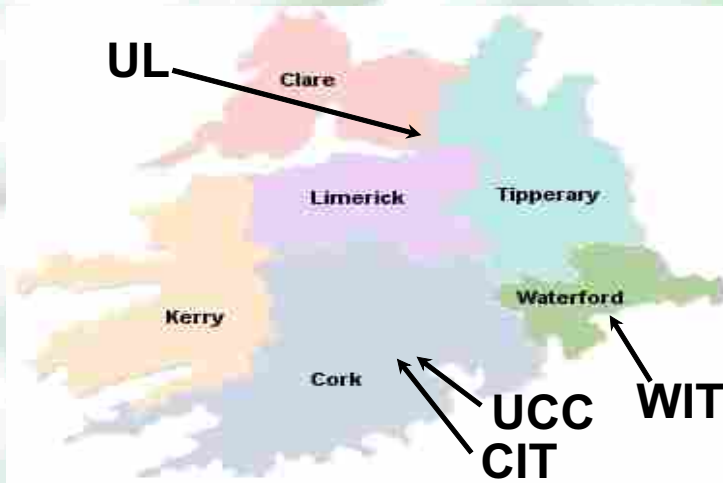
St. John's (Cork), Tipperary Institute, Limerick School of Art and Design...
