

# Prayer Guide

## Belfast Christian Unions

### University of Ulster at Jordanstown CU (150 students)

The CU is looking at apologetic questions this term. Pray that these sessions, along with their studies of Mark's gospel last term, would equip the CU members to answer questions posed by peers and tutors alike.

Pray that conversations which took place as CU members handed out the Free gospels would encourage people to read the gospel and be convinced of who Jesus is and why he came to earth.

Work amongst international students continues to flourish through personal friendships, a café and special events. Pray that this work will continue and be more supported within the main CU body. For Sarah (International Sec) and others already involved, pray that God would continue to be their confidence.



### Queen's University, Belfast CU (400 students)

Pray for the committee as they plan a CU weekend away (19-21 Feb). They will be studying Hebrews 12, looking at fixing their eyes on Jesus for the coming term. Pray that a seminar on how to read the bible with non-Christians would inspire, equip and encourage the students to begin evangelistic bible study groups using Free or to read through Mark with their friends. Our prayer is not only to see people dynamically engaging with God's word but coming to know him personally!



Pray for the 5-week evangelistic series beginning on 15th February with a debate with the humanist society.

Pray for the election of the new committee for the coming year - for honesty, integrity and transparency during the process and discernment and wisdom as the election committee review and pray through the nominations.
